



# Teacher Guide

## 1. HTML

**HTML** (hypertext markup language) is the code that is used to create documents on the Web.

HTML documents are text files that consist of HTML tags (which can place the text or images wherever you want to place them), and text you can place between the tags so that the text will show up on your page when you publish it on the world wide web

**Tags** are instructions that tell your browser what to show on a Web page. They break up your document into sections.

All tags start with a < (left bracket) and end with a > (right bracket).

### 1.1 Creating a class Google account

In order to create webpages that pupils can either publish or return to later, you will need to create a Mozilla Persona account.

Before you can do that you need to have an email account that you can use to create a Persona account.

Create an account that you can use for all pupils in your class.

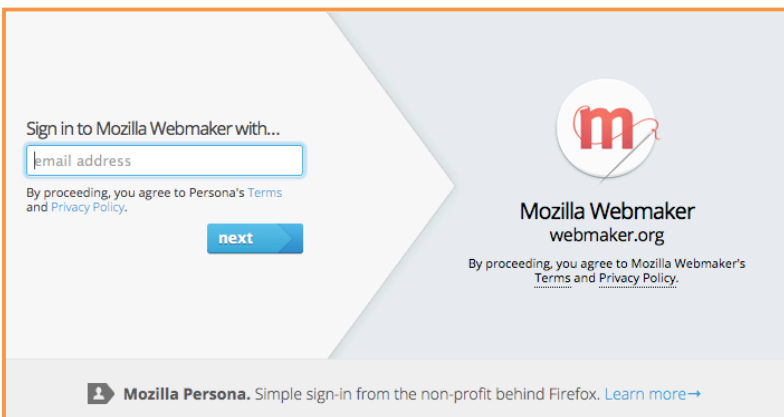
### 1.2 Creating a Mozilla Persona account

Go to <https://thimble.webmaker.org/>

Click on 'Sign In'



You will be prompted for an email address to enter:





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Enter the Gmail email address you created in 1.1

You will be prompted that the email address is new to Mozilla and to create a password:

Your email address is new to us. Please create a password to use with Persona.

cancel done

Create a password for your pupils to use when they log on and use Mozilla Thimble and click 'done'.

You will see a pop-up window informing you that a verification email has been sent to the gmail address you entered earlier:

Check your email

Click the link in the confirmation email sent to **office@icompute-uk.com** to immediately be signed in to **Mozilla Webmaker**.

Check your email and click on the link inside the email to verify your class account.

Click this link to confirm access to **webmaker.org**:

Confirm your account now

You will then be prompted to create a webmaker space that your pupils can use:

Choose an appropriate name and choose 'Create my account'

Your pupils can then sign on to Mozilla Thimble using the gmail address and Persona password.



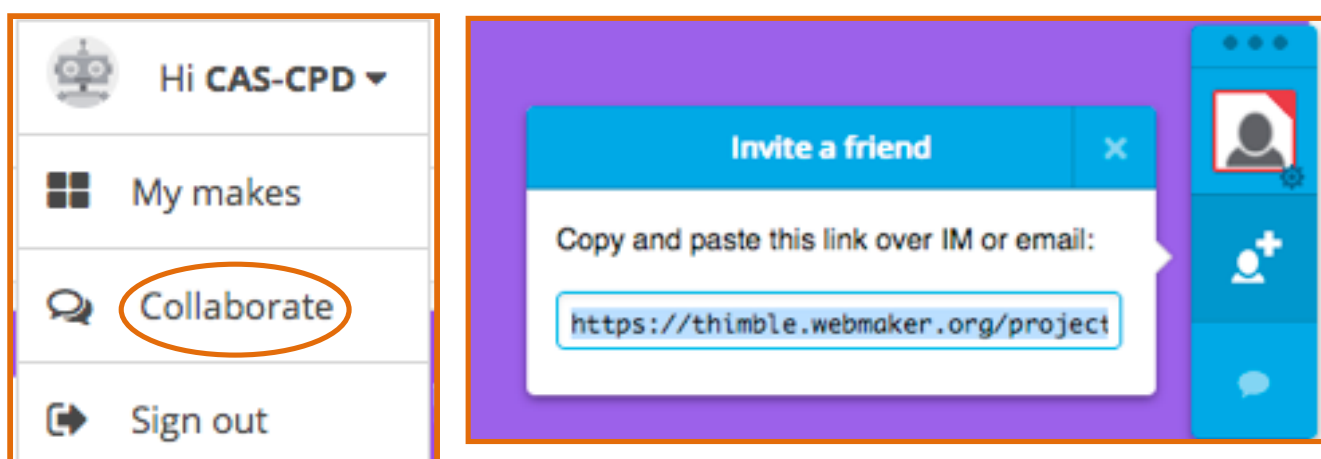


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## 1.3 Collaborating using Mozilla Thimble

When two or more children wish to collaborate on a 'make', they can invite each other to participate in a session using Thimble's collaborate facility. The children then can work on the same 'make' simultaneously and chat online about their project.

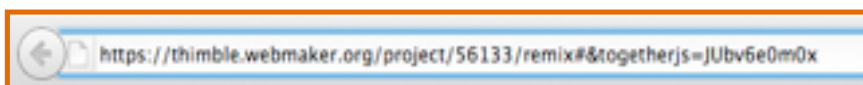
All children should be logged in to the class Persona account. To invite a friend to collaborate do the following:



You are invited to copy and paste the link over IM (Instant Messaging) or email.

You may find it easier to ask the children to copy and paste the link into a Word or Text document on the shared network. Children can then copy the link from the document and paste it into the address bar of a browser to join the session.

Paste the url link into the address bar of a web browser.

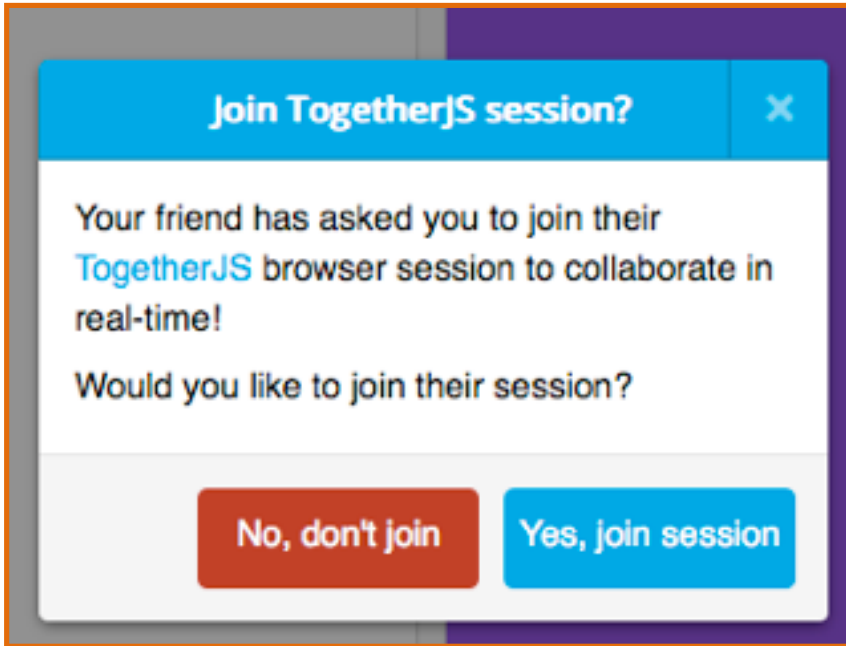


### Join the Session

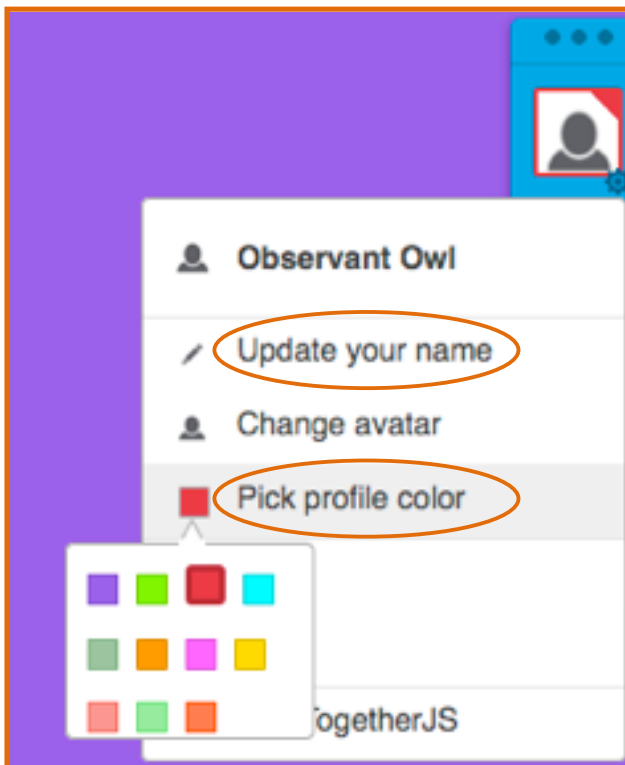
The child will then be prompted to join the session



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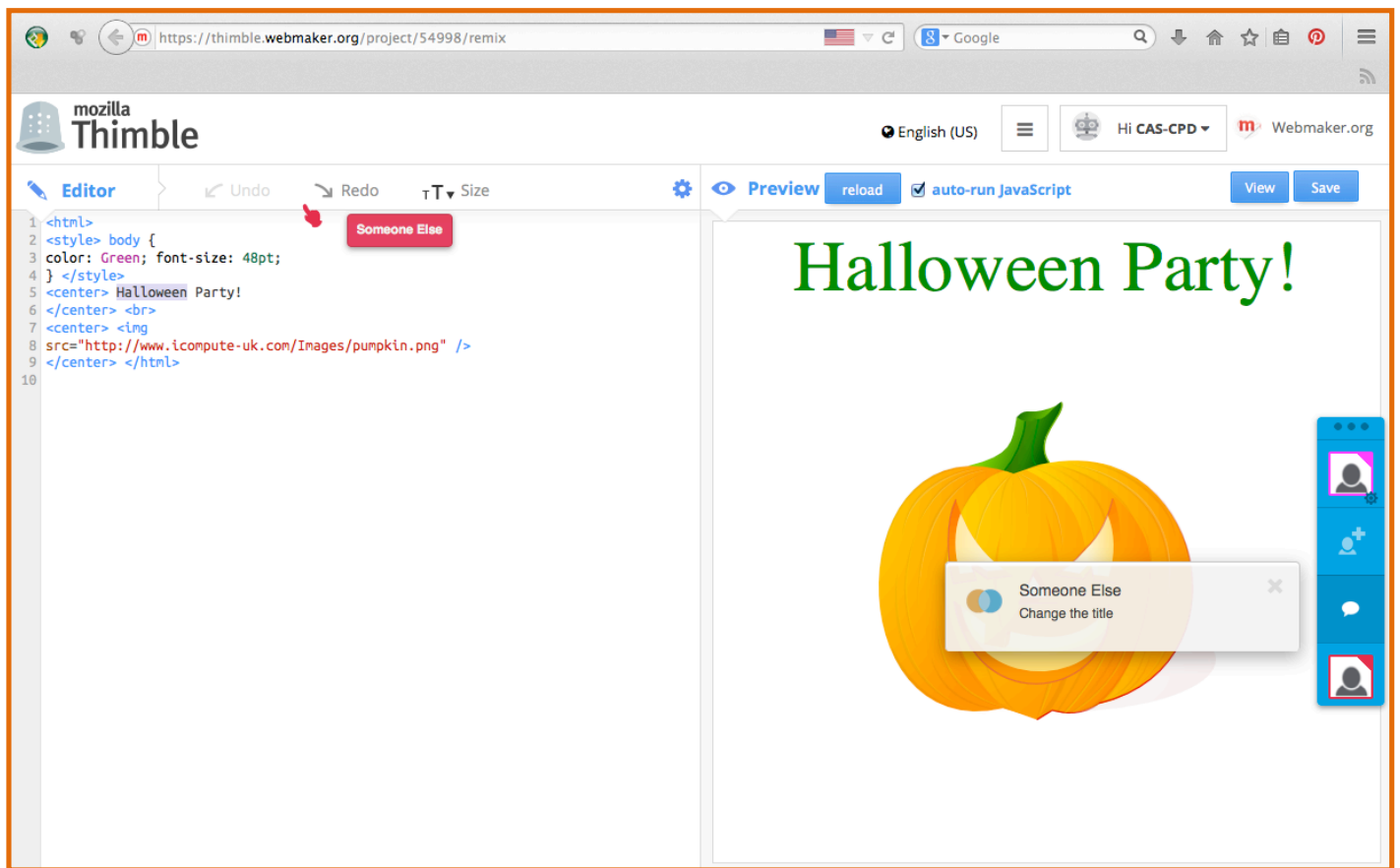
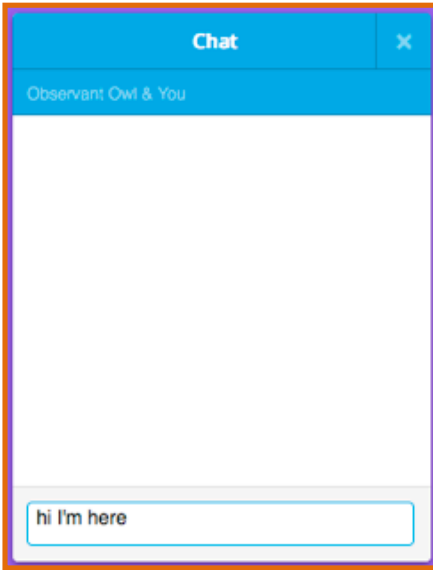
Each child is given a unique name when they join the session, which they can change. It is advisable to change their profile colour which enables each participant to see where, on the web page, they are currently working.
